Abstract

Suzie Earp and Lisa Pierce will present an overview of the efforts of the WRI related to our water archives, on-going research, oral histories and our watershed based geospatial internship program.

The Water Resources Institute of Cal State San Bernardino, which we refer to as WRI, is more than a center for research, public policy and education. We are a unique partnership between university scholars and the communities we serve. The WRI is a place to convene, to study, to meet challenges and to solve problems related to that most critical of water issues, water resources.

More than ever before, in the San Bernardino Valley, the Santa Ana Watershed and indeed in all of Southern California and the Southwest, water resource management, conservation and wise use will determine our capacity for quality growth and economic development. The WRI offers the ideal environment for ongoing progress in meeting water resources challenges.

The WRI is active in water resources arenas of science, public policy and history. The institute was founded, in part, to be a repository for water resources-related and we have an extensive collection of books, historical, research, legal papers; technical database and other water resources related materials. A highlight of our entire collection is a series of papers of political leaders and others who have had a major impact on water resources policy.

Biography:

Suzie Earp is the Historian Archivist of the Water Resources Institute at California State University San Bernardino. She has presented California Water History, and in particular, California Flood History to many different venues including the USDA, historical societies, local and County Museums, and professional organizations throughout the State. Her professional education concentrated in both history and geography, where she won major awards for papers, and presentations. Suzie has held Internships with the U.S. Forest Service, San Bernardino County Archives, and the California Department of Water Resources. She has also been called as a witness to several court cases related to water litigation.

Lisa Pierce is the GIS Specialist and Research Associate of the Water Resources Institute at California State University San Bernardino. She will present the geospatial efforts at WRI, in particular those related to internship programs.
